By the end of class, you'll not only have a stylish pouch perfect for holding your sewing notions, but you'll also gain the confidence and techniques needed to install zippers successfully in future projects.

Whether you're fairly new to sewing or already have some experience, you'll walk away with practical skills that make working with zippers far less intimidating.

Ian will also introduce the delightful world of quilted postcards. These miniature fabric creations are as fun to design as they are to send. During this portion of the class, you'll explore creative design ideas, experiment with fabric combinations, and learn simple finishing techniques that transform small pieces of fabric into meaningful works of art. Quilted postcards are a wonderful way to share your creativity with friends and fellow quilters back home.

Both projects are designed to strengthen your sewing skills while encouraging creativity and confidence. Most importantly, you'll spend time sewing, learning, and laughing together in a relaxed and supportive environment.

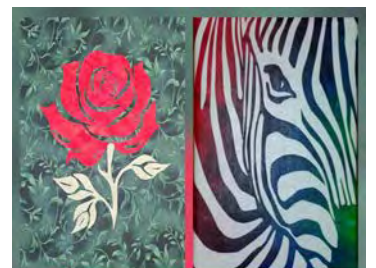
Leo Ransom – Lion's Den Quilting | Class Description

Beginning Portraiture

Discover the fascinating art of fabric portraiture in this beginner-friendly class with Leo Ransom of Lion's Den Quilting. Using just one light fabric and one dark fabric, you'll learn how simple contrasts can transform into striking portraits of people, animals, or even flowers. Leo will guide you through selecting the right photo, creating and printing your pattern, and understanding how to translate an image into fabric. This approachable technique makes portrait quilting both fun and achievable, even if you've never tried it before. If you're ready to explore a creative new skill and see fabric in a whole new way, this class is the perfect place to start.

Intermediate Portraiture

Ready to take your fabric portraiture skills to the next level? In this intermediate class, Leo will introduce his signature technique that resembles reverse appliqué—what he calls the cut-away process. Building on the fundamentals learned in the beginner class, you'll work step by step to create a more detailed and expressive portrait of a person, animal, or flower. Students will choose their subject before class begins, giving you time to prepare and come ready to dive into the creative process. Along the way, Leo may even share a few surprise tips and insights that will deepen your understanding of portrait quilting. Join this class and experience the rewarding process of bringing a portrait to life with fabric.

LEO RANSOM - is an artist, teacher and pattern creator and has been quilting since 1998, beginning as a traditional quilter before discovering art quilting in 2011. Leo is a nationally award-winning quilter, speaker, and instructor whose work has been juried into numerous shows across the country. Leo is inspired by uniqueness in physical appearance and the extreme use of color in creating art quilts.

His award-winning quilts have been exhibited throughout the United States, his original piece "Double the Hipster" received 1st place in the Applique category at the 2022 QuiltCon in Phoenix AZ and is now owned by the International Quilt Museum in Lincoln, NE. His first award came in 2017 at the Dallas Quilt Show for "John Lennon Hidden Notes".

Leo is a member of the American Quilting Society, Fort Worth Modern Quilt Guild and McKinney Modern Quilt Guild. As a member of Trinity Lutheran Church, he also donates time and supplies to Lutheran World Relief quilts. He enjoys giving presentations and workshops to guilds, quilt shops and art groups around the country. Leo lives and works from his studio in Sherman Texas.

Specializing in portrait quilting, Leo works in three styles—silhouette, layering, and collaging—often blending traditional quilting techniques with art quilting methods. Passionate about teaching and encouragement, Leo loves inspiring others to try something new, create boldly, and have fun in the process.
