Gems of Indonesia: Java and Bali with Singapore

Your adventure begins in Southeast Asia with a spectacular tour of Singapore. Explore the grand gardens of this stunning seaside city along with spectacular architecture, timeless temples, and soaring views from atop Sands Skypark before flying to the islands of Java and Bali.

Along the way see epic sights such as the Borobudur Temple, largest single Buddhist monument in the world, and UNESCO World heritage site, two-million stone blocks were used in its construction. The Largest Buddhist temple in Indonesia and it is considered as one of the World Wonders. Built in the 8th century by the Cailendra Dynasty. The name Borobudur is believed to have been derived from the sanskrit words that means the Buddhist monastery on the hill. This Temple was abandoned for centuries and lay hidden under layers of volcanic ash. When it was reconstructed in the 9th century, its overall height was 138 feet. It was rediscovered in the early 19th century by English military engineers. A massive restoration took place from 1973 to 1984, during which each of temple 1,300,232 blocks was restored.

Continue to Prambanan Temple, the largest Hindu temple in the country and UNESCO World Heritage site. This extraordinarily beautiful building constructed in the tenth century during the reigns of two kings namely Rakai Pikatan and Rakai Balitung. Soaring up to 47 meters (5 meters higher than Borobudur temple), the foundation of this temple has fulfilled the desire of the founder to show Hindu triumph in Java Island. This temple is located 17 kilometers from the city center, among an area that now functions as beautiful park. Prambanan also has panels of relief describing the story of Ramayana. Experts say that the relief is like the story of Ramayana that is told orally from generation to generation. Another interesting relief is Kalpataru tree that - in Hindu - the tree is considered tree of life, eternity, and environment harmony. In Prambanan, relief of Kalpataru tree is described as flanking a lion. The presence of this tree makes experts consider that Javanese society in the ninth century had wisdom to manage its environment.

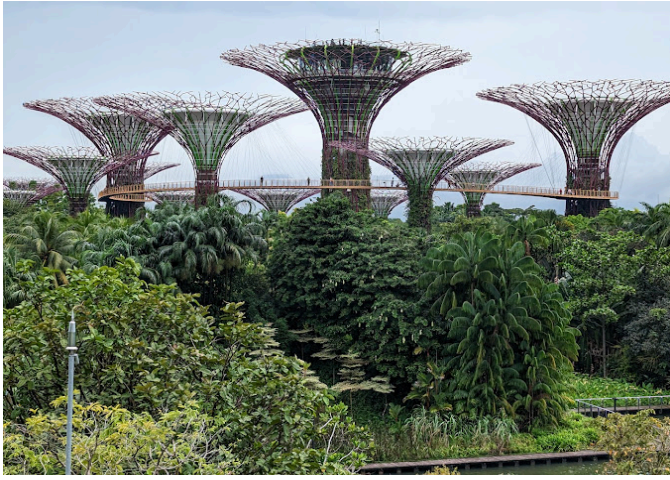
