







#### Taste of Egypt with Jordan - Vacation Overview & Included Highlights

Take an extraordinary journey on this escorted tour of Egypt, beginning and ending in Cairo, followed by a 4-night stay in Jordan. Begin with a 3-night stay in Cairo—called the "Mother of the World"—to explore the legendary sites you've dreamed of seeing. Stand before the Sphinx and the Great Pyramid of Giza and Sakkara's tombs of the kings. Survey King Tutankahmun's treasures at the Egyptian Museum (note: upon its opening, the Grand Egyptian Museum in Giza will replace Cairo's Egyptian Museum in this itinerary.)

In Old Cairo, visit the Alabaster Mosque, situated on the summit of the Citadel. Visit Abu Serga Church built on the spot where the Holy Family stopped and rested towards the end of their journey to Egypt. Also see the 4th century Church of the Virgin Mary (called the Hanging Church), built on the remains of an old Roman Babylon fortress. These and more exciting discoveries are to be found as you see Egypt's incredible monuments to pharaohs and gods of Egyptian history.

Fly to Luxor to embark on your Nile River cruise. You'll visit the monument of Karnak with its ancient, Avenue of the Sphinxes and the Temple of Amun-Ra as well as Luxor Temple. Visit the valley of Kings and Valley of Queens, where the pristine tomb of King Tutankahmun was found with undisturbed riches and splendour. This incredible cruise on the Nile River takes you to amazing ancient sites, including the Temple of Edfu, twin temples at Kom Ombo, devoted to the crocodile god Sobek-Ra and the falcon god Horus. Ponder the magnitude of the task of building the pyramids with a visit to the granite quarries—where an unfinished obelisk still remains. Visit the Temple of Isis, then take a return flight to Cairo to explore the National Museum of Egyptian Civilization and its Hall of Mummies before a felucca ride on the Nile and the chance to browse the bustling maze of the endless bazaar in Cairo's medieval alleys.

Your adventure continues with four nights in Jordan, with a flight from Cairo to Amman. Spend one night each in Amman and Petra, and two nights at the Dead Sea. Enjoy superior accommodations, transportation, and guided sightseeing with expert Local Guides to see the red city of Petra, Roman ruins of Amman, the ruins of Jerash, and the Dead Sea.

- Guided sightseeing, visit the Pyramids and Sphinx of Giza and Alabaster Sphinx , and the "Stairway to the Sky" at Sakkara.
- See the treasures of Tutankhamun's Tomb in the Egyptian Museum; see Saladin's citadel and visit the Alabaster Mosque in Old Cairo; see the Hanging Church and Cairo's oldest synagogue in Coptic Cairo.
- Cairo-Luxor fly to Luxor; visit Luxor Temple, the Avenue of Sphinxes, monument of Karnak & Temple of Amun-Ra; embark on MS Farah for four day cruise on the nice with live entertainment.
- Luxor–Edfu: Valley of Kings, Valley of Queens, Deir El-Bahri, and the Colossi of Memnon.
- Edfu-Kom Ombo: Visit the Temple of Horus; lecture on board; visit the twin temples at Kom Ombo; galabeya party on board.
- Aswan: Sail by felucca to Kitchener Island; visit the Botanical Garden; live entertainment on board
- Aswan (Disembarkation)—Cairo: Excursion to the High Dam; cruise to Agilika; visit Temple of Isis and ancient granite quarries; fly to Cairo.
- Guided Visit to the National Museum of Egyptian Civilization; felucca ride; walk in the maze of shops at the famous bazaar
- Cairo-Amman: Fly to Amman; free time
- Amman–Madaba–Petra: Sightseeing in Amman; visit St. George Church in Madaba; transfer to Petra

#### **DETAILED ITINERARY**

#### Day 1 CAIRO, EGYPT

Welcome to Cairo, "Mother of the World"

#### Day 2 CAIRO

Desert Sands and Secrets of the Sphinx

This morning take a close-up look at one of the World's Seven Wonders and guardian of the great pyramids, the enigmatic Sphinx, and the Great Pyramid of Giza. Cheops, with an original height of 496 feet, is the most colossal pyramid ever built, and of course enjoy the visit to the newly discovered the Noble tombs.

Afterwards, enjoy free time for lunch in a local restaurant.

Drive to Sakkara, a vast desert necropolis built for kings and nobles, and its "Stairway to the Sky," the oldest of all pyramids. Also admire the special tomb of Mary Roca and the Step Pyramid of King Zoser.

This evening, enjoy a Guided Visit to the National Museum of Civilization, displaying a collection of 50,000 artifacts, presenting the Egyptian civilization from prehistoric times to the present day.

#### Day 3 CAIRO

Ancient Cairo, a Boy King, and the Christ Child.

Enjoy a guided visit to the now-famous Tahrir Square and visit the Egyptian Museum\*. Peruse King Tutankhamun's fabulous treasures and many other priceless artifacts of ancient Egypt.

Drive to walled city of Old Cairo, with Saladin's 12th-century citadel, and the Alabaster Mosque of Mohammed Ali.

Drive to "Coptic Cairo" to Abu Serga Church, not only the oldest church in Egypt but built on the spot where the Holy Family stopped and rested towards the end of their journey to Egypt. Proceed to visit the hanging church, which dates back to the fourth century, built on the remains of an old Roman Babylon fortress. Walk to see Cairo's oldest Jewish synagogue, founded in the 9th century.

#### Day 4 CAIRO-LUXOR (EMBARKATION)

The World's Greatest Open-Air Museum

Fly 300 miles up the Nile Valley to Luxor to embark on your Nile River cruise.

See the stunning monuments of Luxor and Karnak, ancient cities whose combined populations swelled to more than one million. Walk among the pillars of the colossal Temple of Amun Ra and along the Avenue of the Sphinxes for an experience you will treasure for a lifetime.

#### Consider an Optional Guided Excursion to enjoy the sound and light show in Karnak Temple.

This evening enjoy live entertainment on board.

### Day 5 LUXOR-EDFU

Royal Resting Places of Kings and Queens

Venture to the Valley of the Kings and Valley of the Queens on the west bank of the Nile where generations of pharaohs and nobles were entombed in Cliffside crypts. See where 62 royal tombs have thus far been discovered, of which one was virtually intact—the splendid tomb of Tutankhamun discovered in 1922.

Visit Deir El-Bahri, Queen Hatshepsut's monumental rock temple. Stop for pictures at the two Colossi of Memnon guarding the valleys.

DISCOVERY - This evening enjoy live entertainment on board.

OVERNIGHT DOCKING IN EDFU

#### Day 6 EDFU-KOM OMBO-ASWAN

Egyptian Gods of the River and Sky

This morning visit Edfu Temple, also known as the Temple of Horus with its menacing black stone statue of the falcon god.

Enjoy a leisurely sail to Kom Ombo.

DISCOVERY Join an exclusive lecture on this ancient civilization by your Egyptologist.

Enjoy beautiful Kom Ombo for a short walk to its bluff-top twin temples. The right side is dedicated to the crocodile god Sobek-Ra, while the left side is dedicated to the falcon god Horus.

Tonight features an Egyptian dinner and a galabeya party onboard.

#### Day 7 ASWAN

Temples from Above and Islands Below

Consider This Morning an Optional Guided Excursion to fly to and see Abu Simbel huge massive sandstone temples (weather permitting).

Board a Felucca (traditional wooden sailing boat) and cross the blue waters of the Nile. En route, see the ancient water measurement system, "Nilometer," on the Nile's Elephantine Island. Visit Kitchener Island's lush Botanical Gardens and the splendid Aga Khan Mausoleum on the left bank.

Consider Joining an Optional Excursion to the Sound and Light show in Philae Temple.

OVERNIGHT DOCKING IN ASWAN

#### Day 8 ASWAN (DISEMBARKATION)-CAIRO

Work in Progress and the Goddess Isis

Join a Guided Sightseeing Excursion at to explore the Granite Quarries that supplied ancient Egypt with its hard stones for the pyramids in Giza. See the famous unfinished obelisk, still remaining in the quarry.

Visit the gigantic Aswan High Dam, completed in 1970. Board a motor launch to the island of Agilika between the two dams. Visit the Temple Of Isis, which was dismantled from the submerged island of Philae and reassembled here.

Board your flight back to Cairo later today, and consider attending an Optional Dinner Cruise on the Nile to celebrate your Egyptian adventure.

#### Day 9 CAIRO

Amazing Civilization and Marketplace Mazes

Start the day with a guided tour of the National Museum of Egyptian Civilization. No visit would be complete without time to experience the Royal Mummies' Hall, considered the crown jewel of the museum.

Take in a full panoramic view of Cairo from the Nile River—on board a traditional wooden sailing vessel (Felucca). Then enjoy a typical Egyptian light lunch (Coshair or Falafel) with yummy ice cream in downtown Cairo.

Browse the maze of shops in the vast labyrinths of the Khan al Khali Souk bazaar and Medieval alleyways.

- Additional advisements may be sent to you.
- Children must be at least 8 years old to travel. There are no child discounts available.
- Confirmation of hotels will be available approximately 30 days prior to departure. In the event of additional departures on the same date, or other events that may result in the unavailability of hotels as listed in the tour descriptions, the accommodations substituted will be equivalent in standard.
- In the event of water level problems or maintenance on the locks on stretches of any river, it may be necessary to operate part of the itinerary by motor coach or alter the program, including hotel overnight when necessary.
- Once deposited, any changes affecting the internal air including but not limited to a date change, tour change, or name change will incur a mandatory change fee of \$250 USD per person as internal air will be ticketed upon deposit.
- Prior to departure, we recommend reading country-specific information on the U.S. Department of State (www.travel.state.gov) or the Government of Canada (https://travel.gc.ca) or the Government of UK (https://www.gov.uk/foreign-travel-advice) website (depending on your country of citizenship). These are good places to learn about the destination you will be visiting, and include information about passports and visas, destination descriptions, safety and security, travel advice/advisories, alerts/warnings, vaccinations, and more. For citizens of other nations, we recommend you consult your local consulate for travel information, regulations, and requirements.
- Full passport details are required no later than final payment for all guests traveling internationally.
- All guests traveling internationally are required to have a passport. Responsibility for meeting the entry/exit requirements (passport validity/blank pages, visas etc.) rests with the guest. Please review the Entry/Exit information included in your Travel Packet carefully for full details about entry and exit requirements specific to your tour. Globus family of brands is not responsible if you are denied entry or exit due to entry/exit requirements not being met.

## Visa Reminder

Non-US Citizens may require a single or multi-entry visa. You must consult with the appropriate embassies to determine if any visas are needed. A visa service such as Generation Visa Services (GenVisa) may be able to assist you with this process.

#### Egypt

A visa to Egypt is required for US citizens.

If you hold a passport from another country, check with your local consulate about requirements for travel to Egypt. Alternately, a visa service may be able to assist you with this process.

Visas can be obtained on tour. The Ground Handler in Egypt will be waiting for guests upon arrival and will hand over a stamp visa to be stuck in each guest's passport. Guests then proceed through immigration. This is an included service that the Ground Handler provides to passport holders of the US, Canada, New Zealand, Australia, and Europe. Passport holders of other countries must get the visa from the Egyptian consulate in their country of origin.

This visa can only be provided for guests that take the included or purchased transfer from the airport to start hotel on published start date or in conjunction with pre-nights purchased through Avalon. Guests are also required to provide flight details. If guests make their own arrangements prior to the start of the tour, they will not be eligible to obtain the visa stamp on arrival and will need to obtain a visa for their entire stay from the Egyptian consulate in their country of origin. Once stamped on the passport the visa is valid for 90 days residence in the country.

#### Jordan

A visa to Jordan is required for US citizens.

If you hold a passport from another country, check with your local consulate about requirements for travel to Jordan. Alternately, a visa service may be able to assist you with this process.

Visas will be arranged on tour unless you are holding one of the following passports. If you are holding one of these passports, a visa must be pre-arranged at a Jordanian Embassy/Consulate in your home country PRIOR to departure (visas cannot be obtained on cruise).

- From Europe: Albania, Macedonia, Moldova
- From South America: Colombia
- From Central America: Cuba, Belize
- From Asia: Philippines, Sri Lanka, Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Cambodia, Laos, Mongolia, Nepal, Pakistan, Vietnam
- From Africa: Angola, Cameroon, Congo, Ethiopia, Eritrea, Ethiopia, Kenya, Mali, Niger, Senegal, Uganda

The included visa arranged on tour will cover post extra nights booked with Avalon or independently booked travel after Avalon services have ended. Details can be given to the Cruise Director once on cruise.

Vacations can be disrupted or have to be altered altogether if the correct documents cannot be supplied at airports or borders, so check very carefully that you have the required papers. These matters generally cannot be settled on-trip.

#### Other Entry Requirements/Documents

All guests traveling internationally are required to have a passport. Passports should be valid for six (6) months beyond the conclusion of your trip, with a minimum of three (3) blank pages for stamps and/or visas. Most countries have laws that require you to carry your passport with you at all times. Responsibility for meeting the entry/exit requirements (passport validity/blank pages, visas etc.) rests with the guest. Check your government's foreign affairs/travel advice website or a local consulate/embassy for the most current entry/exit requirements. Globus family of brands is not responsible if you are denied entry due to entry/exit requirements not being met.
